Introduction

- Bowls BC, in partnership with Bowls Clubs around the Province is focused and dedicated to the growth and development of the Sport of Lawn BowlingState what the audience will learn
- There are 49 clubs in BC
- Clubs belong to one of 4 Regions
- The 2017 membership total was 4,333
- Bowls BC, Regions and Clubs are run by Volunteers
- Funding sources are derived from
 - Members Affiliation Fees
 - Grants from Sport BC
 - Grants from viaSport

Introduction

 viaSports and Sport BC provide grants based on data collected each year from Clubs

Statistics - 2017/2018

- Members 4,333
 - 3039 play at only Club Level
 - 859 play at District level
 - 217 play at Provincial level
 - 81 at national level
 - 22 at international level
 - 115 unknown
- Coaches 370
- Umpires 92
- Markers unknown
- Criminal record checks for coaches unknown
- Social Members 488
- 91% of Members are over 55

- Provides a common method of collecting data
- Clubs have complete control over their membership data
- Membership data can be accessed on any computer, anywhere
- Clubs can enter and keep track of club specific data such as
 - Locker numbers
 - Tag numbers
 - Club Keys
 - Coaches
 - Umpires
 - Emergency contacts
 - Volunteer positions
 - Social members

- Clubs will be able to use the built-in email service (each club having their own private service which will be attached to their current email provider)
- Clubs can create personalized emails to members or sub sets of members (e.g. send an email to volunteers only, or Juniors only)
- Bowls BC always has a current list of Club directors
- Bowls BC has a list of all Coaches in the province enabling the Bowls BC Director for Coaching to contact coaches through-out the province

- Bowls BC has a list of all Umpires in the Province enabling the Bowls BC Director for Umpires to contact umpires through-out the province
- Clubs can keep track of required Criminal record checks
- Clubs can report on their own statistics (number of members, coaches, umpires, volunteers, social members etc.)
- Clubs will be able to generate their own detailed reports

- Security of data ensures only authorized Club members can access their Club Data. No other Club can access another Clubs Data
- Clubs will have access to (and be current)
 - all club directors in their area (contact info)
 - Regional director contact info
 - Bowls BC Directors contact info
- Clubs will be able to enter annual statistics for nonmember participation
- Common search criteria and report templates will be provided in a library for clubs to use.

Features of the Membership System - Technical

- The membership System is a modified version of the SUMAC membership system
- SUMAC is a trusted company providing online membership systems to thousands of non-profit organizations across North America
- Membership Data is stored on a Cloud
- Clubs access their data using easy to install software
- Data is protected and backed up on a regular basis
- Security matrix protects club data

Features of the Membership System - Security

- Membership details can only be seen
 - by the Club that entered the data
 - Authorized Bowls BC Directors
- Contact information (Club, Regional and Bowls BC) can be seen by
 - Club Directors
 - Regional Directors
 - Bowls BC Directors
